I hereby affirm that I have fully read and understand the Statement of Belief and support that it will be a foundational part of my student's instruction.

I understand that the standard of the school and childcare do not tolerate profanity, obscenity in word or action, dishonor to the Holy Trinity and the Word of God, disrespect to the personnel of the school and childcare, or continued disobedience to the established policies of the school or childcare program.

I understand that the services of the school are engaged by mutual consent, and that either the school/childcare or I reserve the right to terminate any or all services at any time. I understand that if I withdraw my students from St. Paul's School or Childcare I must fulfill all financial obligations as outlined in the tuition/childcare fees contract(s). I understand that St. Paul's policies do not contractually bind St Paul's Lutheran School and Childcare and are subject to change without notice by decision of St. Paul's Lutheran School and Childcare governing body. Admission to the school and childcare program is a privilege, not a right, and admission for one school year does not guarantee automatic admission for future years.

We Believe That:

- *All the canonical books of the Old and New Testaments are the revealed Word of God, verbally inspired and the only rule and norm of Faith and of Practice.*

- Programs are subject to availability - priority is given to SPLS Students/Families & Full 4/5 Day care.
- A 12% discount will be assessed for each additional child in full 4 or 5-Day enrollment.
- No refunds available for contract times/days for which a child is not in care.
- The rates listed are for childcare only - they do not cover school tuition.
- Full Day childcare includes 2 snacks. Half Day includes 1 snack.
- Rates are subject to change, and Registration Fees are non-refundable.
- Children that are of school age and readiness will also need to enroll into the school program at the beginning of the academic year.

Monthly Rate Detail

Rates are calculated based on a four-week month over the calendar year. This only adds up to billing for 48 weeks instead of the full 52 weeks a year. The 4 unbilled weeks cover holiday closures, and 8 days of child absences for sick or vacation time.

Holiday Closures:

New Year's Day, MLK Jr Day, President's Day, Easter Monday, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Veterans Day, Thanksgiving and the day after, Christmas Eve and Christmas Day. Times may vary due to day of holiday.
