Field Trip Policy

Our school depends on our dedicated, parent volunteers in order to provide these additional activities for our students. Please read the following:

DRIVER'S LICENSE, PROOF OF INSURANCE, & VOLUNTEER APPLICATION:

To help maintain the safety and well-being of our students, a copy of your driver's license as well as a copy of your proof of insurance must be on file in our school office. A volunteer application will need to be turned in by all volunteers every 3 years. We request that you submit this information to the office several days prior to departure, or arrive with adequate time to make arrangements to supply this important information. You will not be allowed to participate until this information has been turned into the school office. This file will be retained for additional transportation opportunities should you choose to participate at a later date. Please notify our office if this information changes.

CHRISTIAN ENVIRONMENT:

In order to nurture the Christian environment both in our classroom as well as our additional learning experiences, we request that you observe student surroundings that are partnered with our Christian teachings and principles, by monitoring the content of music, movies and other entertainment within your control of your vehicle. This gives our parents and students the assurance that all students will be comfortable and free of objectionable materials.

SAFETY:

For the safety of our students and parent volunteer drivers, our school follows the Washington State Laws on car/booster seat use. Children up to age 4 must use a car seat with a 5-point harness. Children ages 4 and up must use a booster seat until they reach 4 feet 9 inches tall. Children up to age 13 must ride in the back seat.

Students are required to wear their school activity shirts on all field trips unless otherwise instructed by the teacher.

REMINDER:

All day field trips have a 4 hour maximum PIP hour earning and half day field trips have a 2 hour maximum.

PIP hours for overnight field trips will be determined based on required chaperone involvement.
